- **A Worthy Advisor or Past Worthy Advisor in good standing**
- **Under the age of 21 on the first day of Grand Assembly**
- **Has memorized ritualistic work, including Installing Officer**
- **An outgoing girl, neat in appearance**
- **Has the support of her Advisory Board and the members of the Assembly**
- **Understands that Rainbow must come first this year**
- **Understands that she is not permitted to travel alone. All travel plans are to be confirmed with the Supreme Deputy**
- **Realizes that she is representing ALL the Rainbow Girls in PA**
- **Understands she must cooperate with the Supreme Deputy and the Chairman of Grand Assembly**
- **Has a religious background**
- **Must not smoke or drink**

Grand Worthy Advisor Expectations / Standards of Behavior

- Word Perfect Ritual
- Fill in other stations when needed / asked to
- When arriving separate from the Supreme Deputy, check in upon arrival
- When departing separate from the Supreme Deputy, check out before leaving
- In addition to PA Rainbow Dress Code, Crown on = Hair Up
- Give a copy of all invitations to the Supreme Deputy
- Check calendar availability with the Supreme Deputy before RSVP
- RSVP within seven (7) days or before deadline, whichever comes first
- Thank you notes are to be written and mailed within 72 hours for all gifts received
- Expenses are to be turned in monthly for monthly reimbursement.
- Reimbursement is only given with the approval of the Supreme Deputy
