

Hi Girls,

This year, Supreme Assembly has changed the Service Award Program. You have the ability to earn seven butterfly charms and a bracelet. The seven charms are, of course, the seven colors of the rainbow. The charm bracelet will be included with the violet charm when you earn it.

Here is how it works:

You will need to earn 10 hours of service for each butterfly charm. Each color represents a different type of service.

Red – Love: Participate in a community event, such as special events that are city wide – walks for causes, cleaning up parks, streets, etc.

Orange – Religion: Attend religious services, participate in church related service activities.

Yellow – Nature: Assist your Mother Advisor in planning and preparing an outdoor Rainbow event in your area and attend the function.

Green – Immortality: Assist grandparents, board members, or someone who needs help doing yard work, ironing, etc. Working with special needs children would be an idea also.

Blue-Fidelity: Participate and attend a family event such as a reunion, anniversary, or special holiday by helping with planning and preparation.

Indigo – Patriotism: Assist the American Legion, Legion Auxilliary, or other military service organization with projects of their choice, such as aid to military families.

Violet – Service: Assist at a Masonic Organization's Fund Raiser or special project of their choice.

As you earn 10 hours of service in each of these categories, turn in the attached paper to your Mother Advisor, so that she can order your charms. You have until June 2010 to earn your whole bracelet.

You don't need to wait until you have earned all of your charms to turn in your paper. Your Mother Advisor has specific dates to turn them in, and she will let you know when they are due.
