Any member can choose any combination of categories to compete in. Grand Floor Officers and Past Winners (previous to 2008) may only compete in Installation. Rose Ceremony can be found in the Book of Ceremonies but is also available on the PA Rainbow website and through your Mother Advisor. Winner of Rose Ceremony will be performing the Rose Ceremony after Initiation at Grand Assembly.

Participants will be judged in presentation, including tone, volume, speed, and effect. There will be a one point deduction for every word that is either wrong or omitted. There will be a one point deduction for every prompt that is needed.

Participants will also be required to take a written test which will pertain to information Pennsylvania Rainbow Girls should know in general and from the ritual. Any area of the ritual may be used for this test.
