

International Order of the Rainbow for Girls Pennsylvania Grand Assembly 2010 Scrapbook Competition Rules

For Pennsylvania Rainbow Scrapbook Competition an assembly scrapbook is an album where your assembly shows programs, projects, newspaper clippings, photos, and any other publicity items or mementos related to events important to your assembly from 2009 Grand Assembly to 2010 Grand Assembly.

The following is a list of rules and regulations for the 2010 Scrapbook Competition:

1. All scrapbooks must bear the name and number of the assembly on the cover. If the scrapbook does not, it will automatically be disqualified.
2. The weight of the scrapbook must allow it to be managed by one person.
3. The size of the scrapbook must be a minimum of 12"x12" or the equivalent of 144 square inches, to a maximum of 15"x24" or the equivalent of 360 square inches.
4. The cover of the scrapbook must be made and/or decorated by the members of the assembly. You may purchase the scrapbook, but a purchased cover must be covered with fabric or artwork created by the members of the assembly.
5. The book should include programs (Installations, official events, or dinners), pictures, printed material, newspaper clippings, or anything of importance that shows the activities of your assembly between Grand Assembly 2009 and Grand Assembly 2010.
6. Select a theme for your scrapbook. It may or may not be the Grand Worthy Advisor's theme for the year, but you will be judged on how well your scrapbook reflects your chosen theme and how it is carried out throughout the whole book. Plan on including a title page, an index, and page numbers to organize your book. Qualities to keep in mind: originality, neatness, continuity, and creativity.
7. Suggestions for good scrapbooks include: Plan before starting so special events are included, date and label printed material, be neat in pasting and clipping. Include pictures that depict Rainbow, and items of interest from events. Add captions and labels so your book tells a story about Rainbow and your assembly. Include artistic personal touches to tell that story. Avoid material irrelevant to Rainbow. Loose articles that may slip out of place should also be avoided. Be creative and have fun. Let your assembly's personality show. Scrapbooks are great recruiting tools for new members!
8. Judging of scrapbooks will be based on the following criteria detailed on the scoring sheet: size/mechanics, scrapbook cover, internal scrapbook content, labeling/lettering, neatness, and design/creativity. A total of 100 points is possible.
9. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope inside the front cover when delivering your scrapbook to the Grand Assembly judging area. A copy of the scrapbook scoring sheet will be sent to the Mother Advisor or assembly representative after Grand Assembly.
10. PLEASE REMEMBER THIS COMPETITION IS FOR THE GIRLS ONLY, THERE IS TO BE NO ADULT HELP ON THE ASSEMBLY SCRAPBOOK.
